



Is your dog safe in the car?

80% of the temperature rise occurs within the first half-hour.

Even on a cool day, the temperature inside a parked car can quickly spike to life-threatening levels if the sun is out. Precautions such as cracking a window or running the air conditioner prior to parking the car were found to be inadequate.

A car's interior heats up by an average of 40° within an hour, regardless of the temperature outside. Temperature doesn't matter - it's weather it's sunny out.
